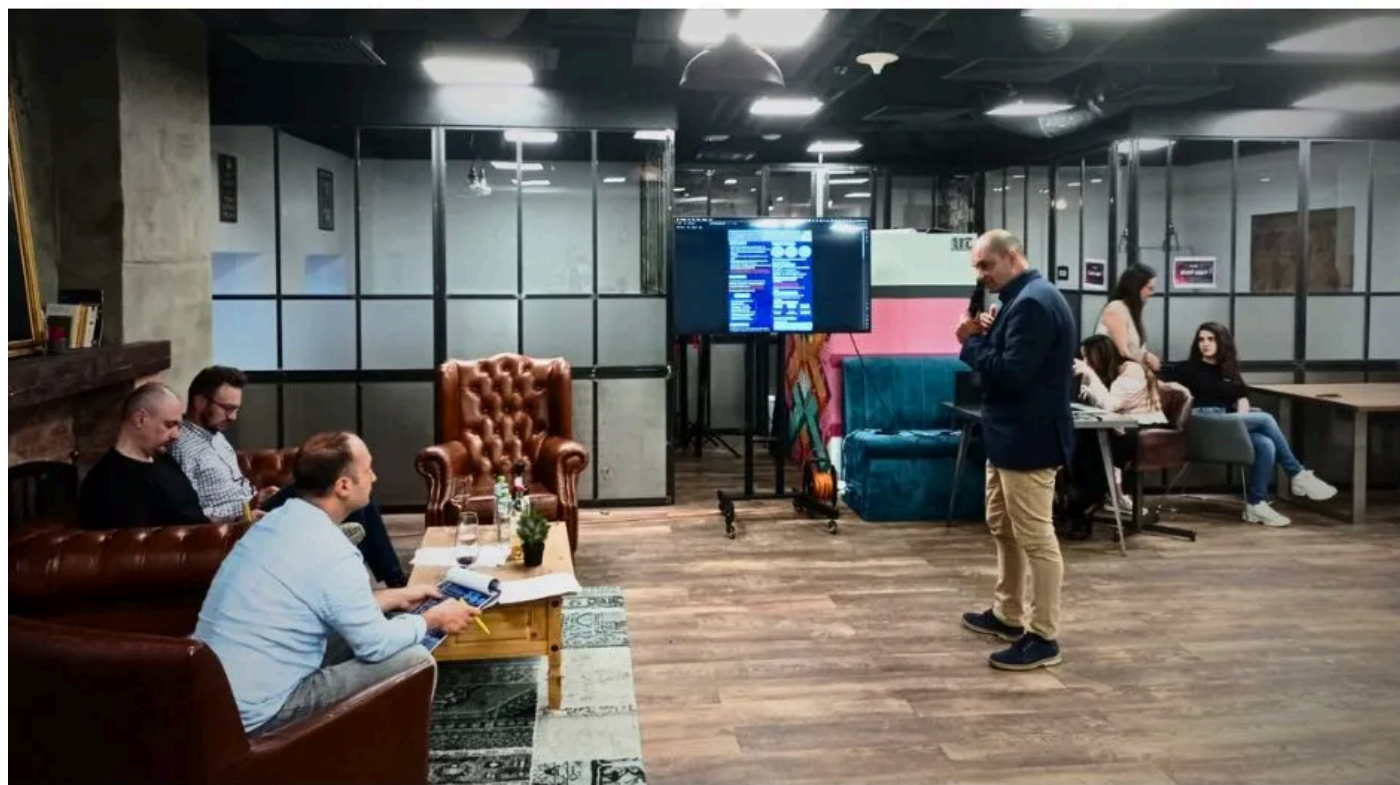

## Romanian business ideas, awarded in Bucharest: ChatGPT application for meetings, online legal services and other solutions presented at Commons Accel 2023

## The Romanian entrepreneurs selected in the finals of the Commons Accel business acceleration program presented their business ideas and startup development plans to potential investors in Bucharest.

The best startups of [the Institute for Entrepreneurship Excellence - IdEA](#) enrolled in the Commons Accel 2023 program, cohort 8, came face to face with potential investors, as well as an audience of over 100 business angels, mentors, representatives of investment funds, the press, or important Romanian and international companies, on Tuesday evening.

## The winners of the DemoDay #8 Commons Accel edition were:

- **1st Place - ActionPoint** - an application that uses Artificial Intelligence (including ChatGPT) to create meeting summaries (minutes), both in real-time, for moderation and agenda tracking, and later, for advanced processing that allows information to be organized in a project-type structure, facilitating access to decisions, current status, and other essential information.
- **2nd Place - My Legal** - a SaaS platform, designed as a unique ecosystem that ensures the integration of legal services into a company's internal and external document flows, throughout their entire lifecycle. My Legal also received a special award from StartupCafe.ro, having the opportunity to showcase their business in our entrepreneurial community.
- **3rd place - Meditații.ro** - a platform that facilitates finding meditation teachers for students, taking into account each person's personality and learning style.

## Special awards:

- awards from the press - along with **My Legal**, **Respiro** was awarded (the mobile application that provides the means you need to understand your triggers, emotional fluctuations and be able to respond quickly and effectively through alternative practices with scientifically proven results).
- a special award for the best pitch, given to the startup **Pitchd** - an innovative online platform designed to connect companies with their perfect creative agency to meet their marketing needs.
- an award given by the entire audience, who could vote for their favorite startup during the event itself, an award that went to the startup **ERDA.AI**, which aims to revolutionize the customer service experience, through a very empathetic and intelligent AI that learns, in a few seconds, from the documentation of any online store and thus facilitates the increase in the "customer satisfaction rate", without the need to scale the customer support department.

## The other finalist startups that presented at DemoDay #8 were:

- **Form a Tronic** - a platform that connects customers, 3D printing service providers and other manufacturing services. The platform verifies models uploaded by customers, creates instant quotes based on them and distributes them to manufacturers with the help of AI.
- **Infrared** - the platform that eases the investment process for early-stage startups.
- **Form Form** - an advanced design research initiative that provides tools, both physical and digital, to enhance designers' skills through technology and artificial intelligence.
- **NuntaMea.ro** - the platform that aims to digitize the wedding field.

All entrepreneurs had the opportunity to demonstrate the progress made during the program and the opportunity to obtain the necessary financing for business development. The jury that evaluated the entrepreneurs' projects was made up of important investors on the Romanian startup scene: Valentin Filip (Fortech Investments), Cristian Dascălu (GapMinder) and Adrian Erimescu (Growceanu).
